RULES OF THE GAME

1. Teams consist of at least four (4) but not more than six (6) players each; non-SGMS players are welcome.
2. Entry fee is \$180 per team, regardless of the number of players on the team; teams are encouraged to sign-up and pay in advance.
3. Pizza and beer will be provided, but feel free to bring additional snacks and beverages.
4. Team members sit together at a table and may discuss among themselves the answers to the questions, but NO OUTSIDE SOURCES ARE ALLOWED. Please leave cell phones, Blackberries, iPhones, books and other outside sources at home. If you must bring a Blackberry, iPhone or similar device, please keep it out of sight.
5. There will be ten (10) rounds of questions.
6. Question will be read or played only twice; teams are encouraged to write down the question as it is being read for future reference.
7. There will be thirty (30) seconds between questions (in other words, after the second reading of a question there will be a 30 second pause before the first reading of the next question).
8. At the end of each round, there will be an additional one (1) minute for team captains to deliver their answer sheets for that round to the scorer's table. Any answer sheets not received within 1 minute and 30 seconds after the second reading of the last question of the round will be disregarded and the team will receive zero (0) points for that round.
9. Format and timing of questions may be adjusted in certain rounds. Please pay attention to the MC for specific round-by-round instructions.
10. After all answer sheets are turned in, but before the next round begins, the correct answers to the questions from the previous round will be read aloud.
11. There will be 15 minute breaks following the fourth (4th) and seventh (7th) rounds.

12. Mulligans: Teams may purchase up to five (5) Mulligans at a cost of \$5 each (or 5 for \$20).
 - (a) No more than one (1) Mulligan may be used in any round.
 - (b) To use a Mulligan, a team must place a Mulligan sticker over the question number for which the Mulligan is being used and may list one additional answer for that question in the space provided on the answer sheet.
 - (c) If either of the answers is correct for the Mulligan question, then the team will be deemed to have correctly answered that question.
 - (d) Mulligans may not be usable in all rounds or on all questions.
13. After all 10 rounds are complete, the team with the most points is the winner.
14. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams.
15. In the event of a tie, there will be additional questions asked, one by one, based on a sudden death format.
16. Decisions of the referees are FINAL; there will be no appeals, challenges, replays or reviews.

Please remember that the Sports Trivia Night is a fundraiser for the charitable activities of the St. Giles Men's Society. Like other SGMS events, one of the primary purposes of the event is fellowship. Please don't take the event too seriously. There is no real money or extravagant prizes to be won – just bragging rights. We have made every effort to ensure the accuracy of our questions and answers and to have an equal amount of very difficult, not so difficult and some rather easy questions for all skill levels.
