
ASP Tool Packing Information

July 2023

As some of you know, Milwaukee Tools has made a significant donation of tools to St. Giles ASP. We were able to work with some of the new tools on skills day and had the benefit of the Milwaukee Tool Truck onsite for demonstrations, how-to's and best practices.

In addition to tools, Milwaukee Tools has generously donated safety goggles, hammers, gloves, tape measures, nail aprons – some of the key items we use on ASP.

The purpose of this note is to provide important information on tool requirements for the upcoming trip.



Crew Supplies: Each crew will have an Ace bucket with 3 hammers, 6 pairs of goggles, 3 tape measures, 5 nail aprons, 2 speed squares, 4 markers.

County Supplies: Each county will have a bin of work gloves, 5 or 6 drills and 1 or 2 saws, N95 masks and extra hammers and pens. Additionally each county will have a sawz-all.



These are all in addition to the ASP provided tools that we will find at the <u>centers.</u>

Additional Tool Suggestions per Crew

Now is the time to talk among your crew to determine what other tools might be needed and who is bringing other supplies, see the following list for ASP's suggestions. No pneumatic tools are allowed.

- insect/wasp spray
- ear plugs
- paint/shade tarp or canopy
- extension cords
- circular saw
- screw drivers
- pliers
- levels
- chalk line
- staple guns/staples

- tin snips
- additional drills
- utility knives/blades
- crowbar
- jigsaw
- sawhorses
- rags
- clamps
- putty knives
- broom/dust pan

Please note that most of the gloves provided by Milwaukee Tools are medium to larger sizes, please bring your own gloves for smaller sizes.

Please note, cargo size will be a <u>serious constraint</u> this trip. We are traveling with 9 large vans and 5 minivans, along with 1 tool van for each ASP center. With cots and mattresses, that does not leave much extra space, just be aware.
