Overview of RMC responses received as of 10-11-2021:

Best scenario:

- 1 in favor of scenario 2-C (St. Edmund and St. Giles/Ascension with SCSL as mission)
- 19 in favor of scenario 4-A (one parish with one ministerial team, new “parish” name)
- 20 in favor of scenario 4-B (one pastoral team, four separate entities)
- 4 in favor of scenario 5-C, (St. Giles with SCSL as mission/Ascension and St. Edmund)
- 5 in favor of one of scenario 4 – either A or B

Least in favor of:

- 2 for 4-A (one parish with one ministerial team, new “parish” name)
- 5 for 4-B (one parish with one ministerial team, new “parish” name) – lopsided, too complex
- 8 for scenario 1 (3 parishes with St. Edmund and SCSL united)
- 12 for scenario 3 (2 parishes with St. Giles/Ascension-St.Edmund-SCSL)
- 1 for scenario 5

Comments:

“Too much to process in a short time”

4-A, “Isn’t this what we are called to do as a Christian community,” “Lots of possibilities”

Most said we need to keep SCSL a part of the larger vision/plan

Challenges:

inspiring parishioners, leadership development, seeing Holy Spirit in process, financial demands with 4 parishes and buildings, how to attract the young, support from Arch with SCSL as mission to west side, how does St. Giles Family Mass figure into the vision for future?
