This has been a challenging year for all of us, requiring everyone to adjust to ever-changing protocols dictated by the ongoing pandemic. Our school children adjusted to months of e-learning; many of us have had to make significant changes to the way we work; and all of us have needed to face the new restrictions of "socially-distanced" living, including in the way that we worship as a faith community.

Our Parish's financial picture has also faced perhaps unprecedented challenges as well. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, St. Giles Parish sustained a net operating loss of \$530,000 – the largest annual loss our Parish has ever seen. Due to a significant drop in enrollment, our school tuition and fee revenue for 2020 was 20% lower than the previous year, and school fundraising likewise saw a drop this year. Our Sunday collections also declined 10% from the previous year, despite the continued generosity and efforts by parishioners to support the parish during the ongoing pandemic.

The Parish has responded by cutting expenses wherever it can and exploring ways to enhance revenue, including increased participation in Empower Illinois grants for school tuition assistance. Through some staffing reductions, the deferral of some maintenance, and other cost cutting, the Parish reduced total expenses by nearly \$300,000 from the previous year. However, the reduced income for the Parish as a whole – including \$500,000 less in school tuition and fees this past year, and a \$125,000 decline in our Sunday and Christmas/Easter collections – was significantly greater, leaving the Parish with a large operating loss for the year. The Parish typically draws down its cumulative savings to cover such annual operating losses, however \$620,600 in funds from the federal Payroll Protection Program helped the Parish cover the losses this year. Our Parish's cumulative savings available to fund operating losses will be largely exhausted in a few short years absent a significant turnaround in our finances.

Thank you to everyone who chose to make supporting St. Giles a priority. As we take this moment to assess and report our Parish's fiscal health, please pray and reflect on what you are able to do to continue and even strengthen that support. Thanks to everyone for all that you do in all ways for our Parish.
