Transitional Shelter a Success!

We expect that the Oak Park Transitional Shelter at St. Edmund School will close on approximately April 3. This is sooner than expected and is due to the excellent work of the Community of Congregations and its Resettlement Task Force placing our Guests in next-step housing.

The Shelter has been a model public-private partnership with the Village of Oak Park and the State of Illinois, and the joint work of the involved faith communities of Oak Park.

Finally, we have been blessed with an excellent temporary staff that has worked at the Shelter 24/7 since it opened. Many staff members hail from Latin America and the Caribbean. They

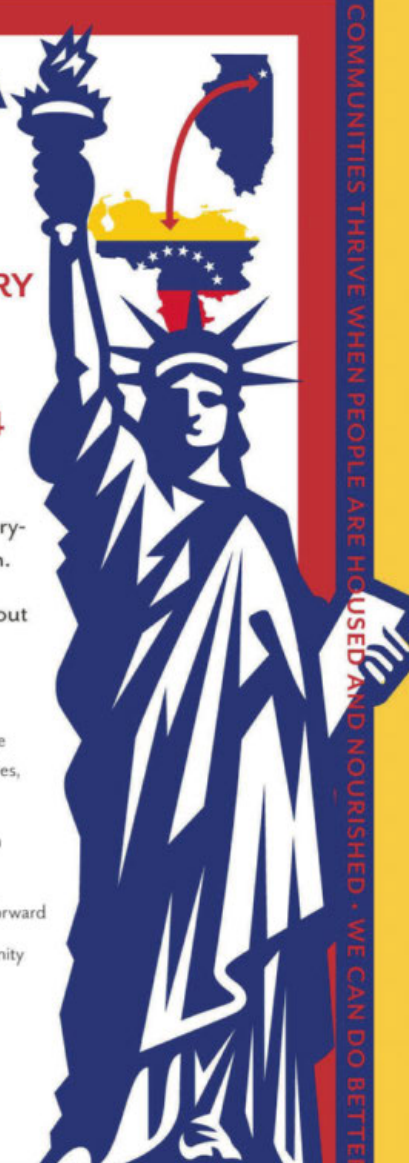

Parish Pastoral Council News

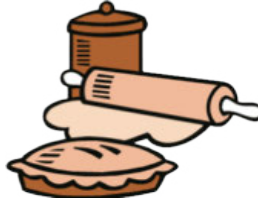

Food For Thought A Community of Believers

"...Everyone who loves the Father loves also the one begotten by him. In this way, we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments...

Whoever is begotten by God conquers the world, and the victory that conquers the world is our faith. Who indeed is the victor over the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?" (1John 5:1-6)

Viewing Thomas as a "doubter" seems unfair and insufficient. If the apostles were convinced that Jesus had risen from death, why would they have been in hiding, locked together in seclusion? John reports Jesus had appeared and said that he was sending them to complete his mission on earth, calling and breathing within them the Holy Spirit.

A week later, when Jesus came to that same hiding place, Thomas was with them, and Jesus asked him to touch the scars from his deep wounds. Thomas did so, and was convinced: "My Lord and My God!" he uttered. Thomas had "walked the walk." Easter is about Faith, lighting the path to salvation, and providing the key to the Kingdom of Heaven.

What Jesus was offering them was what he'd prayed for, nothing less: "May they be one as you and I are, I in them and them in me, so that the world may know that you sent me." (John 17:21-23). The concrete sign of their brand new unity was that the Holy Spirit had drawn them into community, and they overcame narrow self-concern.

Our belief in the Resurrection is a leap of faith that begins with our heart. It helps us discover the meaning in our lives. With that, our love and concern for all in our community is our true identity in Christ.

As we embrace Jesus' victory over evil, we proclaim, "Lord, by your Cross and Resurrection, you have set us free."

Jesus' entire mission was about Faith and Forgiveness. His final words on the Cross give meaning to his life and his death: "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do."
