Housing Forward and Sarah's Inn to launch Safe Bridge Housing for domestic violence survivors.

MAYWOOD, Illinois (February 16, 2024) - Housing Forward, which works to end homelessness, and Sarah's Inn, a comprehensive domestic violence agency, are coming together to form Safe Bridge Housing, a housing program designed for families fleeing domestic violence. The program, funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, will provide up to two years of housing and case management services for households experiencing domestic violence in west suburban Cook County.

The partnership brings together two well-established organizations whose joint goal is for survivors to find and maintain safety through stable housing. Survivors will have access to low-barrier, temporary housing and the financial support necessary to help them quickly move into and maintain permanent housing....

- **Evening Shelter Host**: Volunteers help get set-up for the evening, greet the shelter guests as they arrive, help them to set up their sleeping area, host dinner, and interact with clients until lights out;
- Overnight Attendant: Volunteers support staff in ensuring a safe experience for the shelter guests;
- Breakfast Host: Volunteers serve a light breakfast, help shelter guests exit and assist with light clean-up;
- **Meal Provider**: Volunteers donate a full hot dinner, and/or continental breakfast, and/or sack to-go lunches for 15 people.

SIERRA CLUB Support the **Vehicle Electrification Standards** bill (Illinois SB2839/HB1634) that addresses transportation pollution through setting clean vehicle standards:

- Advanced Clean Trucks Rule Medium- and heavy-duty vehicle manufacturers must increase new Zero-Emission-Vehicles sales up to 40 - 75%, depending on vehicle size
- Heavy Duty Low NOx Omnibus Rule Reduces cancer-causing tailpipe pollution in diesel combustion engines sold
- Advanced Clean Cars II Rule Carmakers must increase new Zero-Emission-Vehicles sales every year up to 100% in 2035

Script: Hi, I'm a resident of [ZIP] joining a bipartisan request to the EAC to expand its AI Toolkit to:

- Provide guidance to state and local election administrators on preventing the use of AI-generated disinformation in campaign ads.
- Ensure that officials are aware of the support and information that the Commission makes available.

I request that you respond publicly to the <u>January 30 letter</u> from Sens. Klobuchar and Collins to reinforce public trust in our elections. Thank you.

- Urge your state to ensure campaign ads contain only accurate information
 33 states (including ILLINOIS) have pending legislation that would regulate the use of computer-modified video, audio, and images intended to deceive the public (also known as deepfakes) in election communications.
 Use this tracker from Public Citizen to find the bill number(s) for your state.
- Encourage young potential voters to register today: Approximately 10,000 Americans turn 18 each day, and anyone who will be 18 before Election Day on November 5 can pre-register so their registration becomes immediately valid on their 18th birthday. Remind your young friends that registering to vote gives them a voice in crucial local issues like housing costs, reproductive rights, community policing, and education.
